Starting from 14<sup>TH</sup> April, the FSTI observed a "*Fire Service Week*" which concluded on 20<sup>th</sup> April. During the week, a campaign for educating people on fire prevention and fire safety measures was carried out which included display of banners and posters, screening of fire related documentaries and practical demonstrations of preventive measures for electrical and LPG hazards.

FSTI is a premier institute of its kind and is engaged in providing specialized training in fire prevention and protection, breathing apparatus and rescue, as well as storage and handling of hazardous material. So far this institute has trained nearly 10000 personnel, not only from the CISF but also from other forces including CRPF,RAF, BSF, Coast Guard, Haryana Police and from PSU's like ISRO,

SHAR, ONGC, IPCL, NRSA and various Steel Plants. In recognition of its professional skills and standards, even the National Fire Service College, Nagpur, the oldest and most renowned Fire training institute of South East Asia, has utilized the services of FSTI for training its Sub Officers.

### **PRE-PROMOTION COURSE**

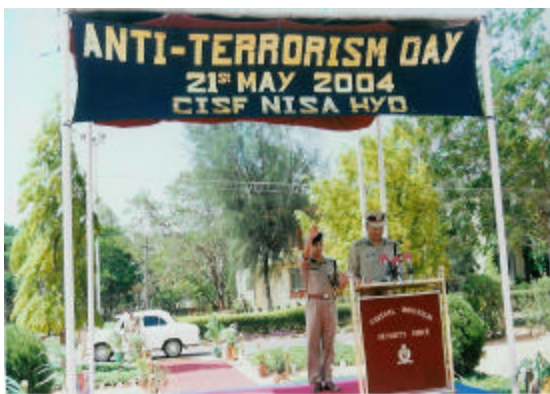
