A course on Disaster Management for District Level Officials was organised at NISA from 12.07.2004 to 17.07.2004. Thirty one officers attended the course from various parts of the country. Shri Madhavan Nambiar, IAS, Executive Director, National Institute of Disaster Management, New Delhi inaugurated the course on 12.07.2004, he also interacted with the participants on “Disaster Management-Perspective Planning : Government of India initiatives”. Inputs were provided on concepts of Disaster management, disaster prevention, sustainable development, multi agency coordination, contingency planning, vulnerability assessment, rescue and relief operations, information management and knowledge of engineering in disaster management.

The 58TH Independence Day was celebrated at NISA Campus with unprecedented fervour and gaiety. The National Flag was unfurled by Shri P.V.K.Reddy, IPS, Director/NISA at 0800 hrs on 15TH August 2004 and the ceremony was attended by NISA staff and their family including trainees. In his address the Director remembered the freedom fighters for their trials, tribulations, aspirations and ceaseless struggle that brought the final glory of independence. He reiterated that as members of the Armed Force of the Union, the nation expects us to maintain high standards of discipline and dedicated service to preserve India's territorial integrity, internal security and democratic structure. He emphasized that the dynamics of change have dictated several novel initiatives within the CISF. The Force is being rapidly modernized both in terms of equipment and training. The manpower intensive units are being pruned with introduction of security gadgets and in highly sensitive installations, security functions have been substantially automated. He also said that many officers and men have undergone intensive training and are positioned for first responder role in natural and NBC disasters. Recently a team of 40 personnel of CISF had rendered commendable services in the flood affected state of Assam for which the Force in general and NISA in particular remembers with reverence and pride late Insp/Fire M.M.Dinakar who made the supreme sacrifice during rescue operations at Assam. The Director NISA later gave away prizes to the winners of drawing competition. He wished all present the best in their quest for personal and professional excellence.

RESCUE & REHABILITATION WORK

A thirty nine member team from Disaster Management Wing headed by Shri Zhoponeyi Zuo, Dy. Commandant from NISA left for rescue and rehabilitation work at the flood affected state of Assam on 14th July, 2004. The team consisted of CMO/NISA Dr. A. Mallik, Instructors of DM wing and Paramedical staff. They rendered yeomen service in saving the lives of flood affected victims. The team was divided into different sections to carry out rescue and rehabilitation work.

On 20th July, 2004, a team consisting of 18 personnel, headed by Shri M.M.Dinakar, Inspector/Fire, was asked by district authorities to visit village Hatinamati to provide medicines. In the process of crossing the river Pagladiya, the boat capsized due to heavy current, and Insp/Fire M.M.Dinakar drowned in the waters of the river. His body was recovered after 06 days. Shri PVK Reddy, IPS, Director/NISA expressed shock over the loss of a resourceful instructor and a valuable member of the Force. His mortal remains were brought to FSTI, NISA Hyderabad by flight from Guwahati. After paying homage to the brave soldier who lost his life for the noble cause, his body was cremated at Hyderabad on 28.07.2004.

OPERATIONAL CONFERENCE OF CISF UNIT COMMANDERS OF ANDHRA PRADESH & KARNATAKA BASED UNITS

Unit Commanders (Andhra Pradesh & Karnataka) operational conference of CISF was held at CISF NISA Hyderabad on 21.09.2004 which was attended by Inspector General, SWS/Director NISA, DIG/DAE and all the Senior officers from field formations. The conference was inaugurated by Shri K.M.Singh, IPS, Director General/CISF.

Addressing the CISF Senior officers DG/CISF said that CISF needs to gear up to the changing scenario and rededicate itself to the cause of security and professionalism. The Director General remarked that the personnel who are deployed in Crime and Intelligence Wing are expected to maintain a high level of integrity and honesty in the discharge of their

duties. As a word of appreciation will work wonders he suggested that those who are doing good work must be suitably and liberally rewarded to boost up their morale while ruthlessly dealing with indisciplined elements.

He further stressed that corruption in units, should not be allowed to happen at any cost. The Unit Commanders should keep a close watch on the dishonest, disgruntled elements and catch hold of such persons and deal them firmly so as to create a sense of deterrence. Director General also pointed out that as the Unit Commanders have the opportunity to directly work with the force personnel, they are in a position to easily identify the deficiencies in the field of operation and bring about improvement wherever necessary. If every Unit Commander works sincerely and honestly, the Force will reach new heights in its style of functioning. If we have the will, there is certainly a way.

DG also pointed out that the aspect of prioritizing work is of great significance. The process of prioritizing will enable us to complete our tasks well in time. All officers were advised to fix up their priorities for the next three months.

Referring to the mechanism of grievance redressal in CISF, he suggested that it should be made as effective as possible. Right from Commandant to Inspector General level, everybody must be accessible. As officers, we have to inspire confidence in the men that their genuine problems will be looked into and redressed expeditiously.

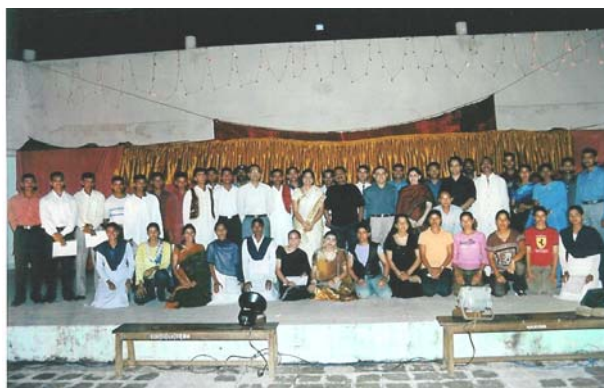
