### **VISIT OF HON'BLE MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) FOR URBAN DEVELOPMENT & POVERTY ALLEVIATION**

Shri Bandaru Dattatreya, Hon'ble MOS (Independent Charge) for Urban Development & Poverty Alleviation visited the Academy on 18.10.2003 and inaugurated Ananda – the Officers Suites, Arogya – the Indoor Games complex and laid the foundation stone for the multi storied complex of the Office of Group Commandant, Hyderabad. In his Address Shri Bandaru Dattatreya said that under the present circumstances the role of military, paramilitary and state police forces have become extremely important in guarding our nation from external enemy and in maintaining internal security. With the addition of Games complex facility, NISA has taken a step forward in the sports arena, which gives immense opportunities to the trainees, staff and members of

the families to groom themselves in moulding their personalities.

The minister elaborated that the society at the dawn of the new millennium faces challenges, which are multi dimensional, multi layered and complex. This would require a multi-pronged and layered approach. The single biggest challenge the civilized world faces today come from ethnic & religious fundamentalism and terrorism of various hues.
