**SMALL ARMS TRAINING SIMULATOR (SATS)**

Among the modern and sophisticated training equipments acquired by NISA, the latest is the Small Arms Training Simulator or SATS. An indoor marksmanship skill trainer, the SATS does not require any special environmental conditions for operating its multifarious systems and caters for training of raw recruits in Hold, Arm and Trigger (HAT) operation with the help of a beeper. The system also allows the firer to choose any firing position viz standing, kneeling or lying down and can be adapted to any type of small arms.
